Reading with a Writer’s eye:

- Make note of figurative language (simile, metaphor, alliteration, etc.)
- Make note of when the author SHOWS VS TELLS (descriptive details, great imagery, specific descriptions, dialogue, etc.)
- Make note of great sentences/word choice

To EARN a 3:

- Use quotes correctly and make note of the page number
- Make a variety of recordings that show analysis/critical thinking
- Show that you can point out examples of SHOWING and FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE
